7g. Request Invitation from the City of Greenbelt to Participate in Peace Month Activities (Attachment #7)

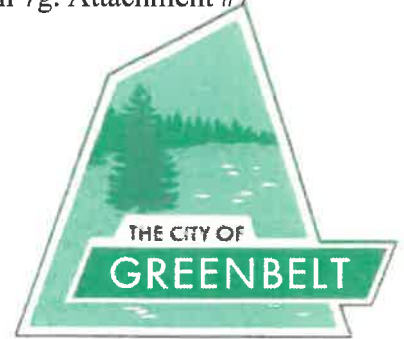
