Meeting called to order at 7:05 p.m.

**Business**

- County bill requiring new construction or properties that undergo significant renovation to provide electric vehicle charging stations. Stefan said GHI is looking into providing EVC stations within GHI, and will be outfitting some garages with them.
- Prince George's County zoning. GHI is still discussing the contents of the County's Neighborhood Conservation Overlay Zone. A work session with the city was scheduled for Sept. 20.
- City plans to use funds coming in from the federal government. Discussed if GHI should speak with the city about its plans for the funds, with a particular interest in storm water management. Money has to be used for Covid related expenses, and storm water management most likely would not qualify, but GHI would explore the issue.
- LGAC will consider submitting questions to the GHI-sponsored forum for Greenbelt City Council candidates.

**Action**

- Notes of minutes from the May 11 and July 13, 2021, meetings were approved.
- Voted to send the letter recommending GHI make a contribution to the Community Associations Institute's Maryland Legislative Action Committee to the GHI Board.
