

#### **Debate Interrupting Motions**

# Parliamentary Inquiry

- •Used to ask the current state of the situation or to determine what the outcome would be if approved or disapproved.
- •"I call a parlimentary inquiry."

### Point of Information

- •Used to request additional information on the matter being discussed.
- "Point of information"

### Point of Order

- •Used if a member feels a breach of the rules has occurred.
- "Point of order."

## Previous Question

- •Used to bring debate to an end. Requires 2/3 vote to end debate and vote on the motion being debated.
- •"I call (or move) the question."

#### Lay on the Table

- •Used to stop debate and hold further discussion/decisions until a future date.
- •"I motion to table the proposed motion (or amendment).
