

## Special Plant Purchase Program Available to GHI Members

GHI is registered with the Maryland Department of Natural Resources Forest Service's TreeMendous Maryland Program. This program allows Homeowner Associations, County or Municipal Governments, Schools, to purchase native trees and shrubs at reasonable prices. As a benefit of cooperative living, GHI is allowing members to request trees and shrubs to plant in their yards as well as in common areas throughout the community. GHI places one order for the entire community and upon arrival, members will be notified to pick plants up from the GHI Administration Building.

Please complete this form and submit it to the GHI Maintenance Department **before Friday, September 22, 2023 at 5:00 p.m.** All requests are subject to GHI approval and GHI reserves the right to modify or deny requests that do not adhere to the GHI Planting Policy.

## HOW THE SPECIAL-ORDER PROCESS WORKS

1. Complete this form and attach a diagram of the proposed planting location. If needed, additional forms are available at GHI's reception desk.
2. Return the completed form and planting diagram to GHI's Maintenance Department. GHI staff will review the request to evaluate plant selection and location. If there is a problem with either, staff will make alternative suggestions. All requests must adhere to the revised GHI Planting Policy in Section V of the GHI Member Handbook.
3. Members will receive a letter from GHI once their plan is approved. At that time members should submit a check to the Maintenance Department for the cost of plants including five percent sales tax. Checks should be payable to: *Greenbelt Homes, Inc.*
4. If members wish for GHI to plant the tree, please check the box requesting Fee-for-Service planting on the order form. The charge is \$50.00 for each tree or shrub and is due upon completion of the planting. Checks should be payable to: *Greenbelt Homes, Inc.*
5. Plants are shipped to GHI, and the Maintenance Department will notify members when the plants arrive. **Members must pick up their plants from GHI within five (5) business days.** All unclaimed plants are used in community beautification projects and no refunds will be issued. Plants for members requesting Fee-for-Service planting are delivered as part of the service.
