4. 2015-17 Waste Removal Contract

In the 4th quarter of 2014, staff solicited bids to for the ongoing service of waste disposal for GDC & GHI. The current contract expires on 1Feb14. For the Parkway Apartments, (2) 6 cu.yd. containers, (2) 90 gal. newspaper recycle toters, and (4) 90 gal mixed recycle toters are placed and planned to be picked up once a week. \$4,000 is budgeted in 2015; staff prepared a bid package to cover a 2-year period, to include services for GHI also.

Bids were received from three (3) contractors for the GDC portion of the work scope:
