## Contract to Treat Invasive Plants, Parcel B – 1st Reading

Landscape Specialist Berres gave an overview of the Forest Conservation Program from its inception in the mid-1970. He reviewed the work he has been doing with the Woodlands Committee in keeping within the framework of the Forest Management Agreement. At this time staff is proposing a multi-stage forest stewardship in GHI's largest parcel, Parcel B. Parcel B is the largest and most ecologically diverse of GHI forest land, and is threatened by a spreading swath of non-native invasive plants that are negatively impacting native plant species and forest health.

Berres described the proposed project stages and explained how the process would be handled. He assured the Board that the work to be done through contracted services would be an integrated pest management approach that blends mechanical, cultural, and chemical tools to control the non-desirable vegetation while minimizing herbicide use.

Because of the sensitive nature of the project, staff will send informational letters to members whose homes are in close proximity of the parcel being treated to make them aware of what is happening.
