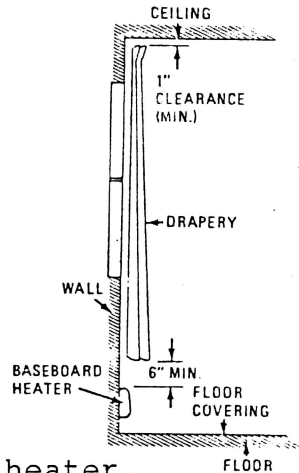


Baseboard heaters are an appliance and therefore care should be taken to operate them properly. For safe operation of the heaters, please observe the following:

- Keep drapes, bedding, shag rugs, toys, furniture, and other combustible objects away from heaters.
- Hem all drapes, curtains, etc. a minimum of 14 inches from the floor.
- Keep furniture, etc. a minimum of 4 inches from the front of the heater and a minimum of 6 inches above the heater.
- Maintain a clearance of at least 2 inches between the bottom of the heater and the tallest strand of any carpeting.

EXAMPLE
Positioning Drapes Near Heater



- Never put anything on or in the heater.
- Do not use the heater to dry laundry by setting laundry over the heater.
- Keep all electric cords away from the heater.
- Do not store flammable liquids near the heater.
- Keep oxygen, if it is required, a minimum of 5 feet from the heaters.
- Keep water away from the heater.
- Teach children not to play with or touch the heater.
- Do not operate the heater without the front cover in place.
- Disconnect power to the heater before servicing.
- Clean the heater at least once a year before each heating season by vacuuming with a wand or nozzle attachment.
- Do not use rubber base paint on the heater. Household enamel paint may be used. Do not paint the inside or back of the heater.
- Do not turn the heat off completely in any room (to avoid freezing pipes). Heat may be turned down overnight or when the home will be empty for more than 4 hours (for energy conservation).
